We made progress on three of five of the lowest scoring areas last year.

- 17% of parents disagreed with the statement that “they were aware of the different computer programs used at Mar Vista.” This is an **improvement** of 25%!)
- 29% of parents disagreed with the statement that “their child spends time on the computer everyday at school.” (This is a 5% **improvement** and our second year of improvement.)
- 10% of parent disagreed with the statement that “their child is challenged to reach his/her potential.” (**This is our best rating in the past four years and a 5% improvement over last year.**)
- 32% of parent disagreed with the statement that “the playground was sufficient.” (This is a 3% **decline** from last year.) This means that more parents than ever are dissatisfied with our playground. Many primary parents wrote that they would like to see a new play structure.
- 18% of parents disagreed with the statement that “their child has access to a nutritional lunch at school.” (This is a 7% **decline** from last year.)

This year we received much positive commentary but we continue to search out areas for improvement. Here are this year’s five lowest areas:

- 32% of parent disagreed with the statement that “the playground was sufficient.”
- 29% of parents disagreed with the statement that “their child spends time on the computer everyday at school.”
- 27% of parents say their child does not use the home computer to complete assignments.
- 18% of parents disagreed with the statement that “their child has access to a nutritional lunch at school.”
- 17% of parents disagreed with the statement that “they were aware of the different computer programs used at Mar Vista.”
